Bell Ringing


Trinity will again be ringing bells for the Salvation Army two Saturdays in Decem-

Did you Know This?

The partridge in a pear tree is Jesus Christ. Two turtle doves are the Old and New Testaments. Three French hens stand for faith, hope, and love. The four calling birds are Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. The five golden rings are the first five books of the Old Testament. The six geese a-laying stand for the six days of creation. The seven swans aswimming represent the sevenfold gifts of the Holy Spirit - Prophesy, Serving, Teaching, Exhortation, Contribution, Leadership, and Mercy. The eight maids a-milking are the beatitudes. Nine ladies dancing are the nine fruits of the Holy Spirit, Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Goodness, Faithfulness, Gentleness, and Self Control. Ten lords a-leaping are the Ten Commandments. The eleven pipers piping stand for the eleven faithful disciples. Twelve drummers drumming symbolizes the twelve points of belief in the Apostles' Creed.
